



Indiana Community Development Projects, Inc. Privacy Policy

Effective Date: August 13, 2026

We are committed to protecting the privacy of our website visitors and other users with whom we interact. This Privacy Policy (“**Policy**”) provides details about how Indiana Community Development Projects, Inc. (“**ICDP**,” “**we**,” “**us**,” or “**our**”) collects, uses, and discloses individually identifiable information (“**Personal Information**”) we collect through our website and other interactions with users, whether online or offline (collectively, the “**Services**”). Please read this Policy carefully before you use the Services or submit information to us.

Your Consent

This Policy is part of the [Terms & Conditions](#) that governs your use of the Services. A link to our Terms & Conditions is provided at the bottom of each page of the Services.

I. Personal Information Collected

We collect the following categories of Personal Information about users:

- Contact details, such as name, email address, postal address, and telephone number
- Grant information, including personal information contained on a grant application
- Audio/electronic recordings
- Geolocation data, such as device location
- Internet or other network information, such as internet protocol address, browser type, browser version, and other unique identifiers, the pages of our Services that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and the content and advertisements you have accessed or seen
- Inferences drawn from any of the information listed above to create a profile about you reflecting your preferences, characteristics, behavior, and attitudes

II. Sources of Personal Information

- *Directly From You.* We collect Personal Information from users when they interact with us. For example, we collect Personal Information users voluntarily provide to us, such as when a user contacts us via our Services, sends us an email, applies for a grant, or otherwise interacts with us.
- *From Other Sources.* We also collect Personal Information from other sources, including from our vendors and from third parties when they disclose Personal Information to us. We may also collect Personal Information about you in other contexts, such as from our grant application platform.
- *Via Cookies & Other Tracking Technologies.* We also collect Personal Information passively via cookies and other tracking technologies (“Cookies”). This typically includes information about our website visitors, such as your IP address, the name of your operating system, the name and version of your browser, the date and time of your visit, and the pages you visit. The information we receive may depend on your browser or device settings.



III. Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

We use Cookies to collect information and support certain features of our websites. For example, we use Cookies to support our website features and functionality, to analyze users' use of our websites and other services, and to improve our marketing efforts.

How Can You Limit or Reject Cookies? To set your Cookie preferences when using our website, you can click the cookie icon in the lower right corner of our website and then set your preferences accordingly. If you would like to reject any non-strictly necessary Cookies we may use, you can click "Reject All." Depending on your Internet browser, you may be able to change your settings to block and/or erase cookies from your device. You can check your browser instructions to learn more about these functions. Please note that if you block or reject cookies and similar technologies on our Services, functionality of the Services may be limited.

IV. Purpose for Processing Personal Information

We may collect, process, and disclose the Personal Information we collect about users to:

- Provide you with information that you request or in which you are interested
- Improve the content, functionality, and usability of the Services
- Provide you with effective user service and communicate with you
- Provide you with a personalized experience when you use our Services
- Contact you with information and notices related to your use of our Services
- Invite you to participate in surveys and provide feedback to us
- Advertise and promote our initiatives, including by contacting users regarding new initiatives that may be of interest to them
- Analyze and better understand users' needs, preferences, and interests
- Improve our marketing and promotional efforts
- Comply with our legal and regulatory obligations, and enforce our rights and policies
- For security, credit, or fraud prevention purposes
- For any other purpose identified in an applicable privacy notice, click-through agreement, or other agreement between you and us

We may also aggregate and/or de-identify Personal Information and analyze those data for statistical or any other purposes permitted by law. When we do so, we take reasonable measures to ensure that the information cannot be associated with an individual, and we maintain and use the information in deidentified form. After it has been de-identified, the information is no longer Personal Information and is not subject to this Policy.

V. Disclosure of Personal Information

We may disclose the Personal Information we collect in the following situations:

- To service providers who process Personal Information on our behalf, including service providers who provide data hosting, information technology support, email hosting, marketing and analytics services, and other services for the operation of our business. We impose contractual limitations on





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our service providers' use of Personal Information they collect in conjunction with providing services to us

- To other third parties at your direction or with your consent
- To other third parties to protect our rights, defend or pursue a legal claim, or investigate or prosecute illegal activities
- To government or judicial authorities to comply with a subpoena, court order, governmental inquiry, legal process, legal obligation, or to protect the rights, property, or safety of other users or the public

We may also disclose aggregated and/or de-identified data to any other entities to the extent permitted by law.

VI. Retention

We store the Personal Information we collect for as long as is necessary for the purpose(s) for which we collected it and in accordance with applicable law, our data retention policies, and our legitimate business interests.

When assessing the data retention period, we take into account the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of the information, the purposes for which we process the Personal Information, whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

VII. Security

We implement reasonable security measures to promote the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of Personal Information in our possession or control. Such measures are designed to protect your Personal Information from loss, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. However, while the security of your Personal Information is of the utmost importance to us, we cannot fully guarantee the security of any information you choose to disclose online. Any information you choose to disclose to us is done at your own risk. If you create an account on our Services, it is your responsibility to protect your login credentials from unauthorized access or use.

VIII. Children's Privacy

Our website is not intended for or directed towards children. Further, for compliance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998, we do not knowingly collect information from children thirteen (13) years of age or younger. If you are a parent or guardian and believe we have collected Personal Information from your child in error, please contact us immediately at info@indianacpi.org so that we can make reasonable efforts to promptly remove all Personal Information relating to the child from our systems.

IX. Third Party Links on Our Services

Our Services may contain links to websites and apps owned by other entities. If you decide to use these links, you will leave our Services.

We are not responsible for the privacy practices or the content of such third parties, and we make no representations or endorsements about them. If you decide to leave our Services to access third party links, it will be at your own risk, and you should be aware that this Privacy Policy will no longer govern. You should review the applicable terms and policies, including privacy and data gathering practices, of any other third party when you navigate away from our Services.





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X. California Shine the Light Disclosure

California Civil Code § 1798.83 permits California residents to annually request certain information regarding our disclosure of Personal Information to other entities for their direct marketing purposes in the preceding calendar year. We do not disclose to third parties for their own marketing purposes the categories of Personal Information listed in California's "Shine the Light" law, such as names, addresses, email addresses, and telephone numbers.

XI. This Policy May Change

We are continually improving and adding to the features and functionality of our Services. As a result of these changes (or changes in the law), we may need to update or revise this Policy from time to time. Accordingly, we reserve the right to update or modify this Policy at any time. When we do so, we will post the revised version of this Policy behind the link marked "Privacy Policy" at the bottom of each page of our websites and provide any additional notice as required by applicable law. To the extent permissible under applicable law, your continued use of our Services after we have posted the revised Policy constitutes your agreement to be bound by the revised Policy. However, we will honor the terms that were in effect when we gathered Personal Information about you.

Whenever this Policy is changed, we will update the "Effective Date" date at the top of this page. We recommend that visitors to our Services review this Policy from time to time to learn of our new privacy practices and changes to our policies.
